

Digital Tools for Teaching: Whiteboards

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Why use digital whiteboards?

Digital whiteboards can be used for **virtual or in-person** instruction.

They make instruction **multisensory and interactive**:



- Visual
- Tactile or kinesthetic
- Learner is doing and creating

Whiteboard activities can be **less preparation** than paper activities.

Digital Tools

	Cost	Notes	Examples
Jotboard	Free maximum of 5 collaborators	account required to create but not to collaborate most like Google's Jamboard	Following directions Grocery cart
Padlet	Free (limited to 3 padlets per account) (can delete padlets to stay within limit)	account required to create but not to collaborate can add video and audio	Matching/sorting Word work game
Zoom	Free	account required best for virtual calls can upload files
