## **Vaccine and Booster Facts:**

- COVID-19 Vaccines are safe for children 6 months and older
- Children get a small amount of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- Children **cannot** get COVID-19 from the vaccine
- Vaccines teach your child's body how to fight the COVID-19 virus
- COVID-19 vaccines do **not** cause fertility problems or issues
- 3 brands of vaccines are available:
  - **Pfizer** (6 months and older)
  - Moderna (6 months and older)
  - **Novavax** (12 years and older)

- Booster shots help your child's body remember how to fight off the virus
- Booster shots help your child's body fight new variants



## **Vaccine Side Effects:**

Your child might have mild side effects:

- Pain in the arm where they got the vaccine
- Feeling tired
- Headache
- Low fever or chills
- Muscle or joint pain

These side effects are **normal** and **stop after a few days.**They show that the vaccine is working.
