Making Conclusions

Dr. Lewis has just completed an investigation in a forest ecosystem observed how the number of prey in the ecosystem affects the number of predators. She then comes to the conclusion that the fewer prey there are, the fewer predators there are. She then predicts that if the number of prey continues to decrease as well.

By looking at the data in her table, she was able to see that as the number of predators decreases, the number of prey decreases. She used evidence from this conclusion. For example, the prey decreased from 1,914 to 1,815 from July to August in the same month.

Dr. Lewis put her data into a table:

Month	Prey	Predators
July	1,914	1,815
August	1,815	1,716
