Able to use the word when speaking/writing.

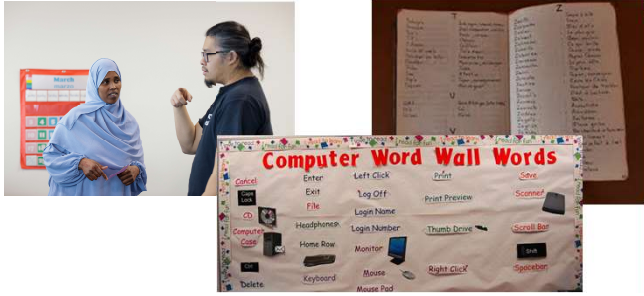
