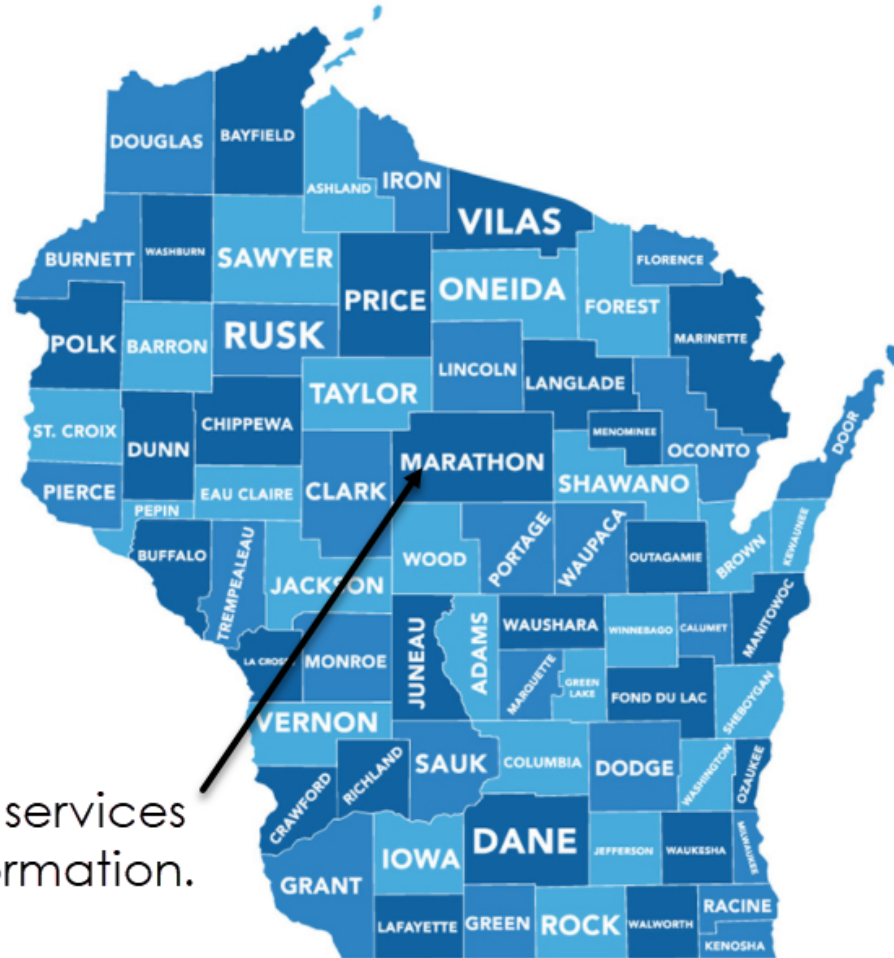

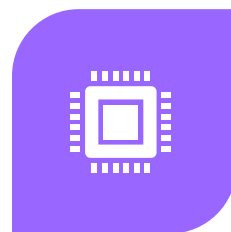

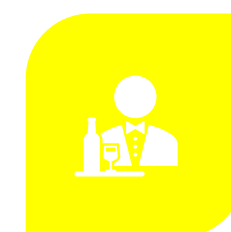

- An agreement between an apprentice, a sponsor (usually an employer), and DWD

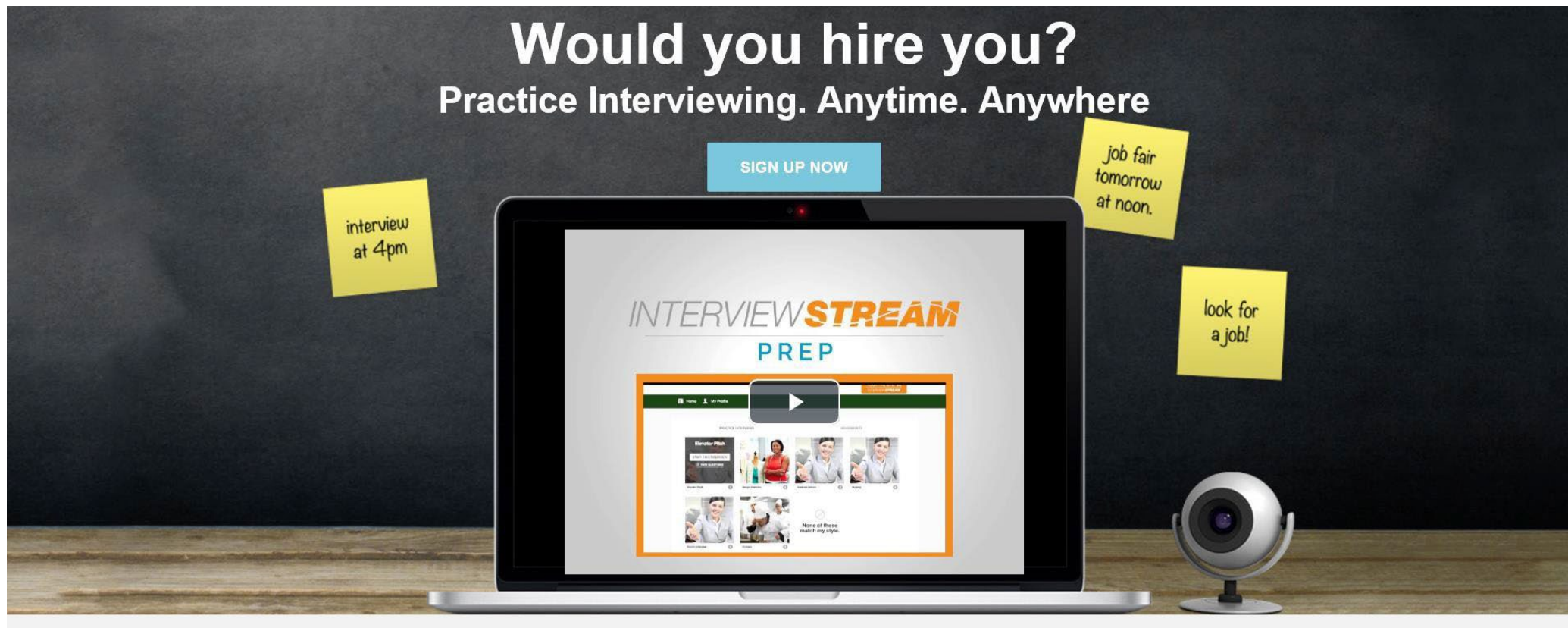
