WHAT ARE THE 3 TYPES OF COVID VACCINES?

- Moderna
- Pfizer
- Johnson & Johnson

THE PFIZER VACCINE

- 2 doses, 21 days apart
- Reduced risk of moderate to severe COVID-19 by 95%
- Reduced risk of hospitalization by 100%

THE PFIZER VACCINE UPDATE

- Children 12 years and older can get the Pfizer vaccine
- 100% effectiveness in 12–15-year-olds
- Vaccines for younger children? Possible later in 2021

HOW TO GET A VACCINE APPOINTMENT

- Go to <https://www.vaccines.gov/search/>
- Choose the vaccine you want
- Enter your zip code
- Choose a location
- ****For children 12-17: Be sure to select “Pfizer” only****

REMINDER

- Vaccines are **FREE** for everyone (ages 12 and older)
- You do NOT need insurance
- You do NOT need to be a citizen or permanent resident

COVID-19 VACCINE BENEFITS AND SAFETY

- All of the COVID-19 vaccines:
 - Protects against severe illness, hospitalization, and death
 - Reduces the risk of all variants COVID-19
- Scientists test all COVID-19 vaccines for safety
- Severe side effects are extremely rare
- The vaccines do NOT give you COVID-19; they teach your body how to fight COVID-19
- Vaccinators watch patients for 15-30 minutes after the vaccine

COVID-19 VACCINE SIDE EFFECTS

- The vaccine might make you feel a little sick for 1-2 days—it means it's working!
- It's also normal to have NO side effects—it's still working!
- These side effects are NORMAL and COMMON for all COVID vaccines:
 - Swelling, redness, pain in your arm
 - Fever
 - Headache
 - Tiredness
 - Muscle pain
 - Chills
 - Nausea
