COVID-19 Vaccine Mini Lesson

Lesson #3: Access, Safety, and Side Effects

Materials:

✓ COVID-19 Vaccine PPT #3

Instructions:

- 1. Open the COVID-19 Vaccine Mini-Lesson #3 PPT in presentation mode.
 - a. Slide 1-2: Title slide and agenda. Explain that today we'll talk about the Pfizer update for teenagers, a new way to sign up for the vaccine, vaccine safety, and side effects.
 - b. Slide 3: Ask if Ss can name the three types of COVID-19 Vaccines. Click through to check the answers.
 - c. Slide 4: Explain that today we will talk about the Pfizer vaccine, which has been in the news lately. Ask Ss to read the characteristics of the Pfizer vaccine.
 - d. Slide 5: Ask, "What is new about the Pfizer vaccine?" Click through the three answers. Ask vols to read.
 - e. Slide 6: Now we'll explore a new way to sign up for a vaccine appointment.
 - i. Read through the steps together.
 - ii. Open the link in slide 6.
 - iii. Go through the steps to show Ss how to register using the website.
 - iv. Remind Ss that if they are scheduling an appointment for a child, they need to select "Pfizer" when choosing a vaccine.
 - v. Put the link in the chat for Ss to use later if they wish.
 - f. Slide 7: Reminder about access. Vaccines are FREE for everyone.
 - g. Slide 8: Now let's talk about benefits and safety of the COVID-19 vaccines (all of them, not just Pfizer). Vols to read through the points.
 - h. Slide 9: Talk about the side effects of the vaccines. Side effects are similar for ALL COVID vaccines. Vols to read the points.
 - i. Slides 10: Share out. T, if comfortable, may share their vaccine story here, then invite Ss to share their stories.
 - j. Slides 11-19: Quiz! All answers are Yes/No. Ask for explanations where appropriate (some are written into the answer!)
