### Medication Label Initiative: Phase 4

- Improving medication directions and reducing patient medication errors
- Increasing use of Universal Medication Schedule (UMS) directions by prescribers
  - 'morning', 'noon', 'evening', and 'bedtime' timings
  - Numerals instead of spelled out numbers
- Improves medication adherence and understanding of when to take medication especially if someone:
  - Takes medication more than once a day
  - Has lower health literacy
  - Over 65 years old





#### Medication Label Initiative: Phase 4

- 3-year project started in July 2021
