For consistency, I will convert the **tú** forms into **usted**:

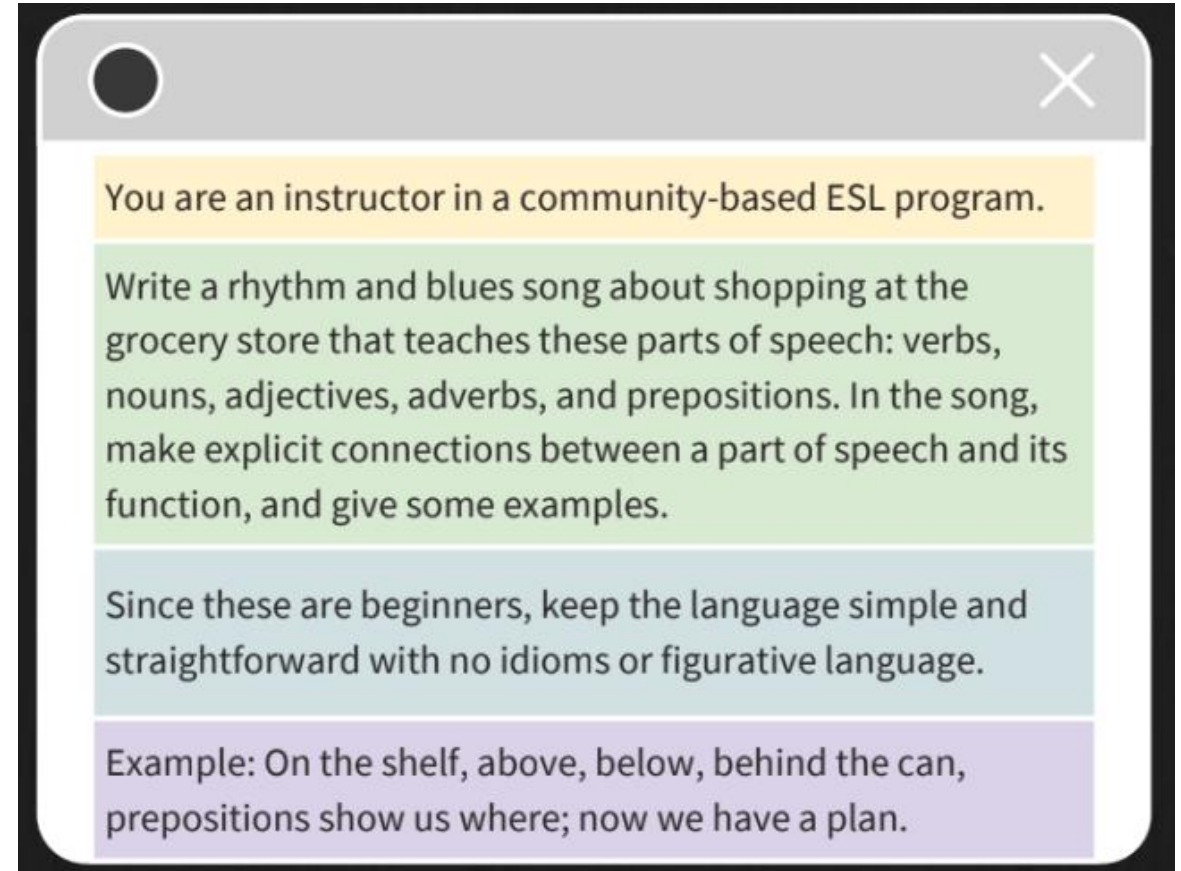
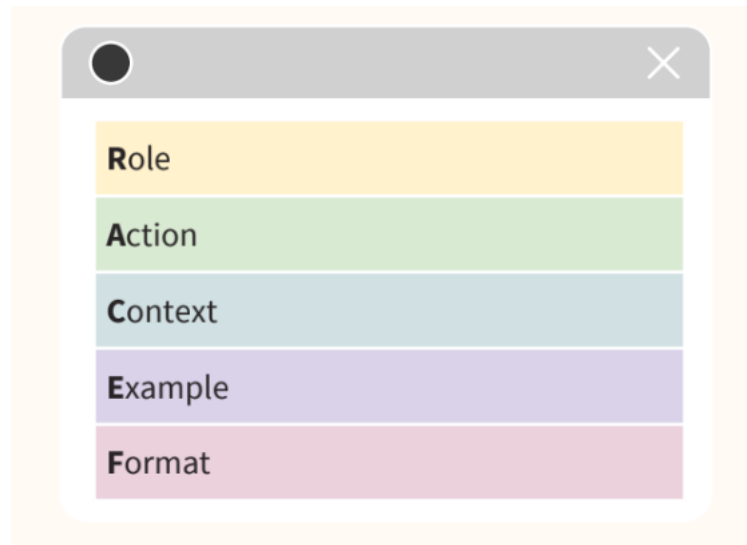
1. Hoy, vamos a ayudarle a configurar su nueva computadora portátil.

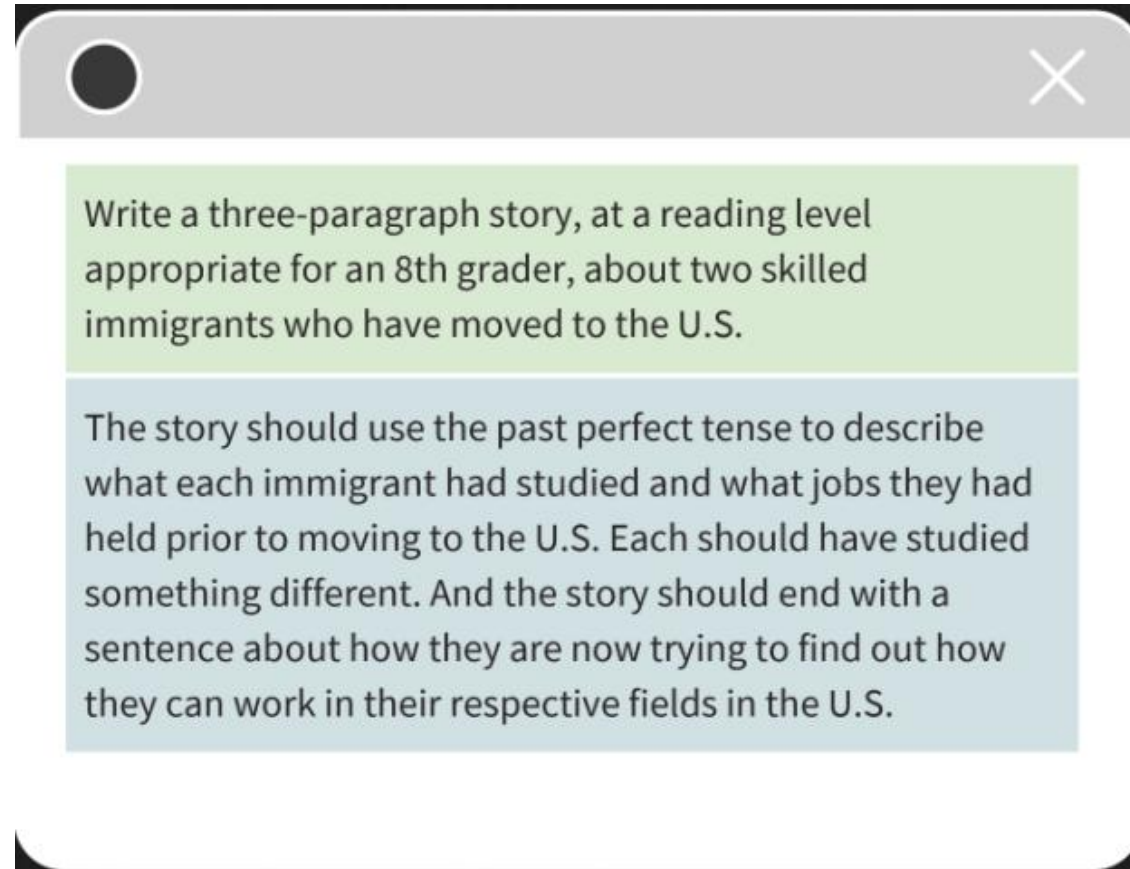
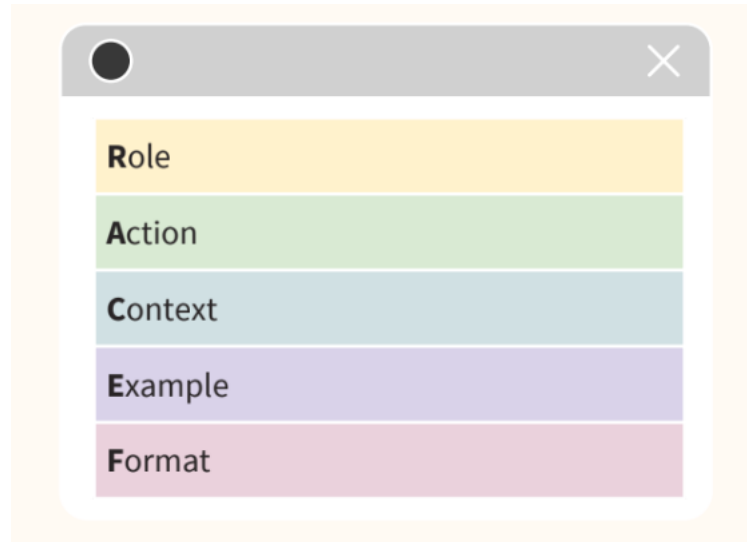

 - Not yet released information or documents
