Subject: Covid-19 vaccine outreach

Thank you for all your hard work in administering and improving access to Covid-19 vaccines. Your efforts have helped Wisconsin residents protect themselves from getting seriously ill or spreading the virus to other people.

We wanted to provide you with some additional information to improve the vaccination rate in your community:

- The federal Covid-19 vaccination program (including the Federal Retail Pharmacy Program) does not require proof of age, occupation, insurance coverage, or citizenship status.
- **You do not need a patient's identification (ID) card or health insurance card to administer a Covid-19 vaccine.**
- **Information is available on how to bill a Covid-19 vaccine for reimbursement if a patient does not have health insurance or an ID card.**
- **Emergency use authorization Covid-19 factsheets are available in multiple languages** for you to give to patients at the time of vaccination and can help inform them about side effects.

Wisconsin Health Literacy Inc., a division of Wisconsin Literacy Inc., implements health literacy interventions across the state. We have been part of an initiative to improve Covid-19 vaccination rates by developing an educational program to help community organizations with their vaccine outreach.
