Vaccine And Booster Shot Facts:

- COVID-19 vaccines are safe for everyone ages 6 months and older
- You cannot get COVID-19 from the vaccine
- Vaccines teach your body how to fight the COVID-19 virus
- 3 brands of vaccines are available:
 - **Pfizer** (6 months and older)
 - **Moderna** (6 months and older)
 - **Novavax** (12 years and older)

- COVID-19 vaccines do not cause fertility problems or issues
- Booster shots help your body remember how to fight off the virus
- Booster shots help your body fight new variants



Vaccine Side Effects:

You might have mild side effects:

- Pain in your arm where you got the vaccine
- Feeling tired
- Headache
- Low fever or chills
- Muscle or joint pain

These side effects are **normal** and **stop after a few days**. They show that the vaccine is working.
