Location is flexible and remote work options are available. This position is for a one-year term beginning August 2021. You will help West CAP Literacy rebuild our Adult Literacy Program to recover from the impact of COVID-19. It is time to renew our literacy program and make it better than ever!

Responsibilities include:

- Recruiting learners and volunteers in Polk, St. Croix, and Pierce counties
- Evaluating and enhancing West CAP's existing tutor trainings through researching other available training options
- Training tutors to use Zoom or other video calling programs for distance tutoring
- Creating a learner orientation that utilizes technology resources

Qualifications:

- Enrolled in or graduated from an associate or bachelor's degree program in Education,
 Communications, Social Sciences or related field
- Strong computer skills and experience using Microsoft suite, online video conferencing, social media, and other platforms used for distance learning
- Ability to work with people with learning disabilities and English Language Learners
- Excellent written & oral communication skills
- Must possess valid driver's license, have reliable transportation, and deemed an insurable driver by our insurance provider prior to hire
- Ideal candidates will have at least basic Spanish conversational skills
